Sir : Extension of AICTE approval to the existing A.B.I.R. INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE & TECH. VIDYANAGAR NELLORE DIST. PIN 524 413. ANDHRA PRADESH for conducting degree courses.

I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert Committee and recommendations made by Southern Regional Committee (dated 26.12.95) & its subcommittee (dated 30.12.95), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has extended its earlier approval to A.B.I.R. INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE & TECH. VIDYANAGAR, NELLORE DIST. PIN 524 413, ANDHRA PRADESH upto session 1996-1997 for conduct of following courses with an annual intake and duration as given below :

This approval is subject to fulfillment of specific conditions as enlisted in annexure-I and general conditions as enlisted in annexure-II.

The Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall not announce admissions directly under any circumstances and shall lawfully comply by Admission Regulations notified by the AICTE vide SOR 476(2) dated 20.05.1994 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 16.02.1993 with regard to AP (C) No. 567 of 1992 in the case of Uday Krishnam JP and others etc. Vs. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgments.

In the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of any of the conditions, guidelines, norms, and regulations prescribed by the AICTE from time to time the AICTE or a body of person(s) authorized by it shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of the approval or recognition without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions. AICTE may inspect the institution at any time it may deem fit to note progress.

You are requested to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decision of the AICTE and continuously monitor the progress made by the institution and communicate it to the Southern Regional Committee of the AICTE under liaison to this office.
