In response, N. Sai Sireesha (III - CSE) and N. Samlesh (I - CSE) expressed their gratitude for the institution's well-developed infrastructure, placement training, advanced laboratories, and sports facilities. They also requested the enhancement of institutional excellence through continuous orientation programs focused on advanced programming skills and increased interaction with industry experts to align with evolving industry demands.

The Director appreciated the students for their communication skills, leadership qualities, and aspirations for a bright future. He emphasized NBKRIST's commitment to providing updated spectrum of facilities in align with industry requirements and assured the students that their suggestions would be considered to further enhance institutional resources and training opportunities.

1. Review on minutes of IQAC meeting held on 10/10/2024

The IQAC coordinator briefed about the implemented activities congruent with prior recommendations made by the members in the previous IQAC meeting, such as the deposition of earned regular exam credits into students ABC accounts through the NAD portal; in alignment with the NEP-2020 policy, the creation of APAAR IDs for all first-year students; and the submission of NAAC-AQAR reports for the academic year 2023-2024.

2. Initiation of activities concerning to NAAC 4th cycle submission

In concern to future activities, the IQAC office is aimed at conducting sanitation programs on the topic entitled 'NAAC accreditation/Key Indicators/Qualitative & Quantitative Metrics/Data preparation and submission' for all teaching faculty members. IQAC members have provided their valuable suggestions for the smooth conduction of regular academic audits for each even/odd end semester exams.

3. Placement Cell contribution for enrichment of intra/inter 'sphere head' guidance for the students.

Dr. N. Kishandar, Training & Placement Officer, described in-detail about all training/skill orientation programs conducting to the IV, III, II-year students in view of their future job aspirations in core/software MNCs. In addition to regular academic curricula, Training & Placement Cell is providing Java, Core Java programing skills by trained external experts to the students. Continuous and regular verbal/language communication skill developing programs have been conducting for overall benefit the students. Dr. N. Kishandar quoted that, appreciable number of girls are succeed in recent Infosys screening tests and further training programing are designed to equip the students with necessary advanced skills to the successes. The placement officer revealed that, Training & Placement team is in constant touch with core industry experts (CIVIL, ECE, EEE, ME) and extending the fruitful negotiations in order to enrichment of campus recruitments in core industries.

4. Research and Consultancy activities at department level.

In regard to the research and consultancy activities at each department level, all the IQAC members unanimously agreed to consider the implementation of necessary scientific activities at concrete level in order to ensure the development of R&D activities and further improvement of the institute's position in the NIRF ranking in the near future.
